#### **SHERWOOD FOREST VISITOR CENTRE, EDWINSTOWE, NG21 9RN**

We suggest you car share. Bring tables, chairs and picnic hampers and make a day of it! Remember to bring hats, sunscreen and water to keep hydrated, on a hot day!

Drive up to the Visitor Centre to unload. Your driver will then need to proceed to the car park (3 minutes' walk away) to park.

There is an accessible car park, next to the centre, for blue badge holders, which is payable - £7.

The car park fee is £7. Ticket machines accept cash, card or contactless device. Any problems, pay the car park fee in the gift shop. Display the ticket in the car.

RSPB members can park for free, by displaying a valid RSPB membership card.
